Dolomiti Superski announces that it has today been informed by the Italian Competition Authority (AGCM – Italian Competition and Market Authority) of the outcome of the proceedings initiated last year.

Over the past several months, we have worked closely with a team of experts to provide a transparent and comprehensive explanation of how the Dolomiti Superski system operates, and we are pleased that the Authority has deemed our commitments to be appropriate.

Starting on October 15, eligible customers will be able to choose between requesting a refund or receiving a discount on future purchases by providing proof of the purchase of a 1- to 31-day valley-ski pass during the 2022/2023, 2023/2024, or 2024/2025 winter seasons. Implementing this initiative will require the development and launch of a dedicated online portal by several Dolomiti Superski departments, while the Company will be responsible for carrying out a thorough review of each individual application. This represents a significant organizational effort aimed at rewarding our customers' trust while preserving the services and quality standards that guests have come to expect from Dolomiti Superski.

Customers will be informed through Dolomiti Superski's communication channels about the procedures and timelines for applying for refunds or discounts, with sufficient notice to allow them to take advantage of the initiative.

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
